NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON DEFAULT BALANCES PAYABLE TO THE DISTRICT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the BCCSD committee has filed a report with the District setting forth a public hearing to place a lien on the real property of individuals that have a Default Balance payable to BCCSD. The purpose of the lien is to allow the District to recover funds due to it for payments owed to BCCSD.

Prior to placing a lien on the real property of the individuals associated with a Default Balance, BCCSD will hold a public hearing to give any interested person, including all property owners in the District, an opportunity to comment on, or protest any Default Balance. The public hearing will occur on Saturday, August 1, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. at the Butte City Fire Station, Hwy. 162, Butte City, CA 95920. If you oppose any Default Balance, you may protest to the District prior to the close of the public hearing orally or in writing. At the public hearing, the District Board of Directors will consider the protests in determining the final amount of each Default Balance.

Written protest must be received prior to the close of the public hearing. They must include the name, address and signature of the drafter, and should be sent to:
